A REPORT OF THE MISSION IDEA CONTEST 2 (MIC2) SEMINAR HELD IN NIGERIA

The First Mission Idea Contest 2 (MIC2) seminar held in Nigeria, took place on 3rd of March 2012, in the Physics/ Astronomy department seminar room of the University of Nigeria, Nuskka.
