

IAA Award in the 3rd Mission Idea Contest for Micro/nano Satellite
Utilization
Terms of Reference

1. Overview:

On the occasion of the 3rd Mission Idea Contest for Micro/nano satellite utilization, the International Academy of Astronautics will award the IAA Award to recognize “Fostering international collaboration in space projects”

2. Eligibility for Nominations/ Applications:

Among finalists selected by MIC review team, those who submitted full paper which has potential to foster international collaboration will be nominated. Hence, no need nominations/applications for the IAA award.

3. Purpose:

To recognize outstanding paper of micro/nano satellite application for high potential for the needs of international collaboration.

4. Criteria for Selection:

The award will be given the best paper dedicating to the needs of international collaboration among selected paper as finalist in the 1st stage.

5. Selection Procedure

The IAA evaluation committee for MIC3 will choose the recipient(s) of the Award by full paper and oral presentation held on November 19, 2014.

6. Type of Award:

The award consists of a certificate and high visibility.

7. Award Presentation:

The Award will be presented at the 2nd UNISEC Global Meeting in Kitakyushu, Japan.
